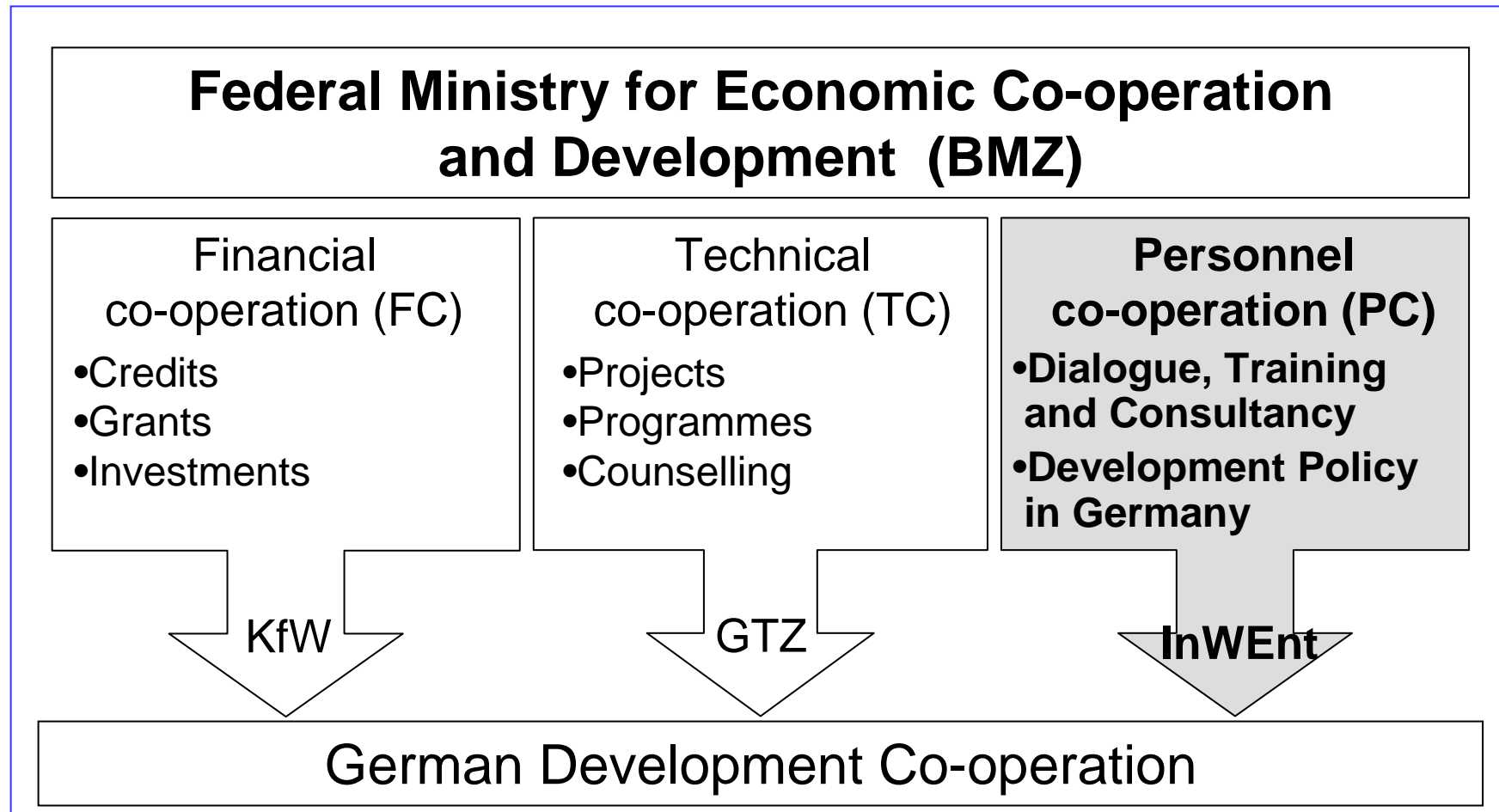

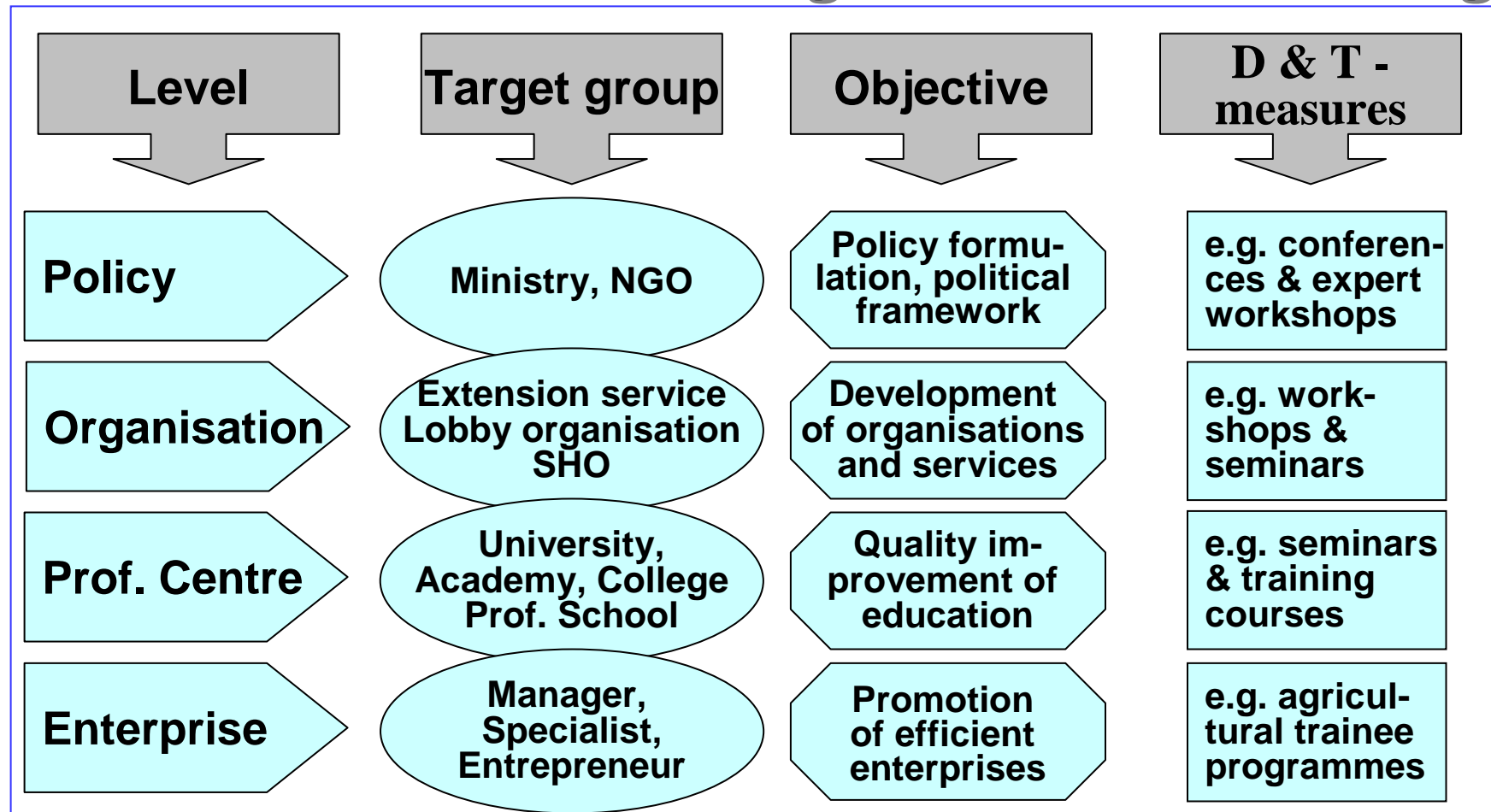
CEEC & NIS: Objective
